

## Clinical Research Grants

Cancer League of Colorado will accept research grant requests that focus on enhancing participation in clinical trials. The purpose of the Clinical Research Grant is to help address the need for more funding directed towards clinical research on the local level. The Clinical Research Grant should:

- Focus on Phase I, II, and III NCI-approved clinical trials that are addressing cancer prevention, treatment and symptom management research in Colorado
- Focus on reducing barriers to participation, educating patients about clinical trials, educating physicians about clinical trials, or other related programs
- Demonstrate the applicants history of involvement with cancer clinical trials

### Applications

The Cancer League of Colorado Cancer Research Grant Application Form must be utilized for application to be considered for funding. This will be page one of the application. The Narrative portion of the grant should be concise and include the following:

**Abstract of Grant Request** – This should be in lay terms and no longer than ½ page.

#### Organization information

- Mission statement and a brief statement of the organization's goals and objectives
- Brief summary of the organization's history
- Description of current activities and accomplishments
- Description of institution's experience with clinical trials and its ability to manage this project

#### Purpose of the grant

- Statement of need
- Description of project goals and measurable objectives
- Description of activities planned to accomplish these goals
- Timetable for accomplishing goals
- Brief explanation of clinical trial(s) that will be the focus of this grant and provide protocol numbers provided by the NCI in your application. Please also furnish a copy of your Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval for human subjects

#### Budget and Budget Narrative

- A detailed, categorical budget must be supplied
- A budget justification that sufficiently explains each budget item and why each budget item is necessary for implementing the project
- The budget and the budget justification have a strong correlation with the goals and objectives, and the activities described within the application

#### Evaluation and Key Personnel

- Description of the methods that will be used to evaluate this program
- Description of key personnel

### SUBMITTAL

Applications must be submitted in two formats: an electronic version and 3 paper copies (original printed electronic application with official signatures plus two copies).
