Cancer League is a truly unique organization. We are an all volunteer (no paid staff or offices) fundraising group dedicated to the eradication or control of cancer. All of our operating expenses are covered by membership dues and generous support from our donors. Cancer League of Colorado now has over 400 volunteer members who share the commitment to fight cancer and support cancer research.

FUNDING THE CURE WITH CARE

Since its humble beginnings in 1969, Cancer League of Colorado has raised and dispensed millions of dollars to support cancer research, patient care and family programs in Colorado.

Each dollar donated to research through Cancer League generates about 20 times that in additional funding.

Cancer League-funded research has been successful in leading to groundbreaking discoveries, particularly in the field of genetic research.

Since our incorporation in 1985, we have awarded over \$10 million in research grants and service awards.



SERVICE GRANTS

Approximately 15 percent of the money raised by Cancer League is used to help fund service organizations throughout Colorado that provide support directly to cancer patients and their families.

Cancer League was a founding supporter of the Ronald McDonald House and Brent's Place. We also provide service grants to hospices throughout the Front Range, as well as cancer recovery and family support programs such as Casting For Recovery, Camp Wapiyapi and Clinica Tepeyac.

RESEARCH GRANTS

Approximately 85 percent of the funds raised by Cancer League support early stage cancer research. The money is provided as grants for projects that are selected by the Funds Allocation Committee. In turn, these projects tend to generate results that warrant additional research funds from other organizations such as the National Cancer Institute. Funds Allocation is based on recommendations of Cancer League's Scientific Advisory Board, a group of Colorado medical specialists who represent a variety of cancer research and treatment disciplines.

We support many institutions including University of Colorado Cancer Center, The Children's Hospital, AMC Cancer Fund, Porter Care Hospital, National Jewish Health, St. Mary's Hospital and the Medical Center in Grand Junction.

Our legacy grant supports opportunities for summer internships for High School Seniors and College students to assist primary researchers at the University of Colorado Cancer Center.

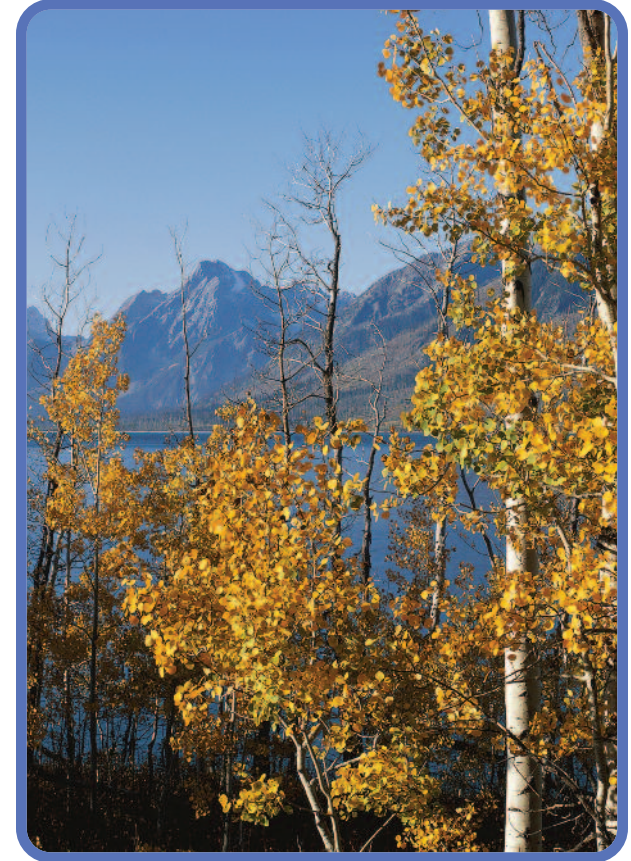
